Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 8:00 am

Public Comment: None

Ms. Smith reviewed the quotations and timeline for achieving the paving of the areas behind the transfer station.

2027 Minimum fee, currently \$25 minimum for up to 500 lbs. was discussed in detail regarding an increase to the minimum fee to deter the frequent/regular use of the facility by small load vehicles (cars & SUV's) congesting the building and increasing safety risks. Businesses and Commercial Haulers must be serviced efficiently.

The facility has seen a significant increase in tons over the last several years elevating safety risks and congestion in the station. While it is understood that the services MCSWA provides are for all residents of the County, we must remain focused on providing a safe environment for all with the knowledge that our Businesses and Commercial Haulers are more than 93% of the MCSWA revenue. The committee concluded that this discussion should be open to all members and will be discussed at tomorrow's Regular Meeting.

2027 Rates Review was discussed and tabled for future approval.

2027 Commercial Recycling pull fee was discussed and will remain the same for the new year pending future review.

2027 Preliminary Draft Budget Summary Page reviewed.
